Problems you may encounter

Please note, the SkyFIT manual blind is a "goal post" design comprising of a headrail and 2 x side rails. The blind is designed to fit at the edge of your recess and to be fitted as square as possible. The blind is side fixed at the edge of the reveal so if your reveal is not square the blind will not operate well. We therefore suggest if your recess is out of square to square it up and pack it out a little during installation to ensure the blind is fitted square.

<u>Top tips:</u>

Always make sure you operate the blind in the centre of the handle with the control rod or your hands. If you decide to put screws down the side channels, make sure you do not over tighten them and dont pull the side rails out of square.

The blind keeps opening by itself

The brakes which are on the bottom bar of the blind are not engaging properly in the side rails. This is probably because the recess is slightly out of square. Reduce the width between the side rails by packing out the sides of the recess a little bit. This should bring the side rails closer together and give the bottom bar something to grip on to
